Information Statement

At the invitation of the Chairman, M.Shafik Gabr, of the Shafik Gabr Foundation, Gabr Fellows met in Washington DC on Saturday 30th October 2021. A list of Gabr Fellows that attended the meeting and dinner is attached (annex 1).

The first part of the meeting took place at the Foundation offices and lasted for three hours in which an agenda was covered. Agenda is attached (annex 2).

The get together focused on reigniting the relationship between the different annual groups of the Fellowship that visited Egypt and the US along with their Egyptian counterparts. The American Fellows in attendance updated news of their present activity and outlined their present status and their future endeavours.

Another key discussion point was a proposal by the Chairman to hold a reunion of all Gabr Fellows of all the classes in Luxor, Egypt in February 2022. After much discussion and recognition of several Fellows work on this topic, including but not limited to Bryan Griffin and Moataz Hussein, it was agreed to focus on the February 2022 date in Luxor, Egypt. These dates were agreed upon.

The group then discussed the Chairman's plans to restart the 'East-West dialogue' initiative in Fall 2022 and to reopen the application process in mid-February 2022. Several suggestions were made and discussed, however at the end of the meeting it was highlighted that the present format of 24 Gabr Fellows being chosen after a 5 step selection process and travel to Egypt for 12 days and 12 days in the US is the most effective.

Other subjects were discussed. Please see agenda (annex 2) attached.

The following action points are underway:

- 1.) Support from Erika Witt to engage with the 2014 Fellows, whilst Dan Sullivan will contact the 2013 Fellows, Suzanne Youngner and Chase Bowman will contact the 2014 fellows, Magda Kura and Murray Abeles will contact the 2015 Fellows, Kevin DeWar and Katherine Tan will lead with the 2016 Fellows, Hunter King will lead with the 2017 Fellows and Charles Truxal with the 2018 Fellows.
- 2.) Hunter King will assist in developing a plan to focus on the Egyptian Caucus in Congress with both members and staffers.
- 3.) The Chairman will meet later in the month with Gabr Fellows in the New York area and with Gabr Fellows in Egypt in December.
- 4.) Phoebe Stephenson shall undertake weekly follow ups.
